“Exploring Alternate Feed Stocks and Addressing Environmental Issues in Distilleries”

India is the second largest producer of sugar and fourth largest producer of alcohol in the world. It is also the leading producer of alcohol in the South-East Asian region with about 65% of the share. Sugarcane, the raw material for sugar mills, is one of the leading crops of the country. Molasses, a byproduct of sugar industries is the major raw material for distilleries in India. With an annual molasses production of around 11- 12 million tonnes, the alcohol production through molasses route remains around 2400 – 2500 million liters.

To achieve a target of 10% EBP, which now has been announced by Govt., the demand of alcohol for fuel sector shall be approx. 2300 million liters, which shall be nearly equal to current total capacity of distilleries through molasses route. So the demand of all sectors, potable liquor, industrial and EBP can be met only when we search and use alternate non-conventional agricultural and cellulosic raw materials for alcohol production. Further Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has also stipulated very stringent norms for proper disposal of the spent wash so as to ensure zero liquid discharge.
